Pax Christi,

This Thursday is the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord into heaven. It is the completion of the forty days since He rose from the dead, completing the important number (40) that had been used throughout salvation history to mark important actions. Ascension Thursday is no longer a holy day of obligation in the Church, and we will not be using next Sunday as a day to celebrate Ascension Thursday (on a Sunday) - and thus 43 days after the Resurrection. So, we urge you to make an effort to get to Mass on the Thursday to mark the feast. To that end, there will be two Masses on Thursday, Noon and 7pm at St Anne's.

Last Sunday I mentioned the Sons of the Most Holy Redeemer and their current status in the Church. To clarify, I shall quote their official communique released last week. *"Therefore, we call for an Imperfect General Council, a meeting of all Catholic bishops of the world who have kept the true faith, to pronounce on the status of the present papal pretender, Leo XIV, and on the status of his Conciliar Church predecessors."* This denunciation of the status of Pope Leo as the legitimate Pope is sad and at the same time alarming. We must all reach out to God with our prayers for a resolution to this situation. The phrase 'Bishops of the world who have kept the true faith' is problematic also because it begs three questions, 1. *What is the definition of the phrase 'who have kept the true faith'?* 2. *Who will be the person(s) to decide which Bishops have kept the true faith?* 3. *What criteria have been used to measure the amount of the true faith a Bishop has?*

Martin Luther decided that the hierarchy of the Catholic Church were no longer legitimate due to their sinful lives and heretical teachings. He believed that he had kept the true faith and called on others who agreed with him to protest against the establishment church. In the end, he became the arbiter of where the true faith was, he proclaimed who was and who was not a true believer and ultimately he left the Church although he claimed he was not leaving the church, but reforming it.

The Church is the perfect bride of Christ as she is holy in her Founder, holy through her sacraments, and holy in her doctrine. Yet she is also a ship tossed about in the waves of great storms, a ship battered and damaged. But, with Our Lord sleeping soundly on the deck, ignoring the wind and waves, with Peter at the helm, we must trust that Our Lord knows what He is doing (at all times). Let us offer up our prayers, sacrifices and mortifications for the Church, who is our Mother. Let us not lose hope, but hold on to those things we know to be important. Love God, be in the state of grace.



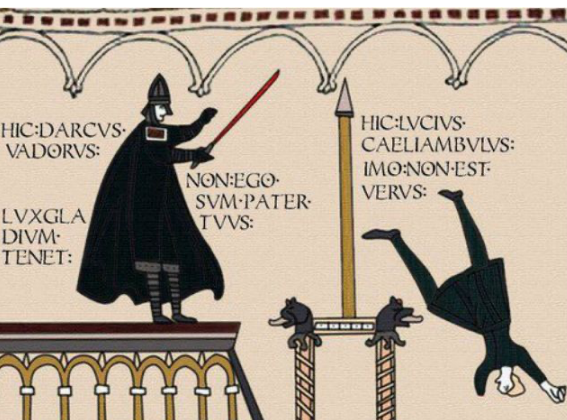
