As we announced last week, we give thanks to God for the ordination of 12 men this past Thursday for the FSSP in the USA. Fr Lai Nguyen FSSP, pictured below, was one of these 12 men, and will be stationed here in Auckland, as the Assistant Chaplain to Fr Sumich. God willing, he will arrive at the beginning of July to start his first assignment. Please keep him in your prayers.

As also announced last week, Fr Pospischil will be transferred to Australia (the exact Apostolate is still to be confirmed). He will formally leave Auckland on 5<sup>th</sup> October, but he has been requested to fill-in at various apostolates in Australia for a few months. So, he will be leaving tomorrow before returning to Auckland on 17<sup>th</sup> August. He will then remain with us till his transfer on 5<sup>th</sup> October. During his absence over the next couple of months, Fr Pospischil will not be able to be contacted via his NZ phone number while overseas.

The following is a message from Fr Pospischil: "I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for their prayers and help over the past three years. Auckland was my first assignment as a Priest, and as such, it has helped form me into the Priest I am today. It has been a privilege to get to know you and serve you in some way. I leave here with many fond memories. As Priests, we are meant to offer the sacrifice of the Mass to God and help bring the faithful to God, I pray that I have done this for you. Please be assured of my prayers, and I will see you all in a few months."
