Pax Christi,

In this week (beginning today) we ask that you join us in a novena of prayers to St Peter, Prince of the Apostles for Church unity and an end to schism. The novena will begin today (21<sup>st</sup>) and conclude on the Feast of St Peter (29<sup>th</sup>). I asked Bishop Lowe if I could add in the Orations (Collect, Secret & Postcommunion) for "Church Unity" on days on which they were permitted and he gladly acceded to that request. It is so important for us to put to prayer these requests as God is happy with our supplications for His Church. Of course the reason for these extra prayers are the planned Episcopal consecrations of the SSPX on July 1<sup>st</sup>. The Holy Father spoke on Friday imploring them to reconsider this act which will impose sever their union with the Holy See. Further to that there was the news this week of the intention of Fr Michael Mary FSSR to receive Episcopal consecration also, with his being from a Sede-Vacantis Bishop, thus denying the validity of Pope Leo. So, let us all join in this novena. We will all have to wait and see what is the response from Rome if and when these consecrations take place.

I ask your prayers also for the repose of the soul of Mr Graeme Smith one of our Sunday attendees who has been with us since 2020. Mr Smith was a shining example of trust in Divine Providence. Although his children no longer practice the Catholic Faith, Graeme made sure that he organised all things for his eventual passing. He prayed a lot for the grace of a good death, he made sure his son and daughter-in-law were very aware of his needs. So, when his health began to decline (less than a month ago), they rang me to come to the hospital. He received communion, then was transferred home and he communicated the next two Sundays (including last Sunday), then when his condition became worse (Thursday) I was contacted again, he received the Last Rites and the Apostolic Blessing, and he gave his soul to God on Friday. God is truly powerful when He can organise a passing so perfectly! Graeme's funeral will be at St John the Evangelist in Orewa at 11am and will be a Sung Latin Mass.

Things are moving swiftly for the organisation of the Footsteps of Pompallier Pilgrimage. The raffle tickets will be printed this coming week and will be on sale from next Sunday and registrations are now open. We are still looking for some volunteers, so please speak to Catherine Opie (or email her) if you think you could help out in some way. This year will be even bigger and better than it was two years ago. I encourage all of our youth to consider walking this pilgrimage in the footsteps of our first Bishop.
