Pax Christi,

Tomorrow, is the Feast of Ss Peter and Paul and we will conclude our Novena for Church Unity and to end schism. Thanks to all who have kept these prayers going. We will never know the value of our prayers in this life, but in the next life it will be made abundantly clear just how important prayers are. Let's ask St Peter to protect and strengthen the Holy Father as he faces this rupture against his authority.

Our 8am and 5pm (Hikurangi) Masses today are the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost, but the 10am is the External Solemnity of Ss Peter and Paul. As the Feast will fall on the Monday, and St Peter is the primary patron of the FSSP, we are able to celebrate his feast on the Sunday to give due respect to the Prince of the Apostles and his role in the FSSP. Speaking of Peters and the FSSP, please welcome Petar Majetić, an FSSP seminarian to Auckland where he will be joining us for all of July as part of his seminary placement as ongoing formation. Petar has just completed his 3<sup>rd</sup> year at Our Lady of Guadalupe Seminary in the US. He is from Sydney, 'Straya and is of Croatian origin (idemo Hrvatska!).

Also, Fr Lai Nguyen will arrive in NZ on Wednesday to begin his first assignment as a priest. He has been saying Masses in the US over the last month, but the last week he has been in Vietnam visiting family and saying some first Masses there. He has asked if he can celebrate a special Mass at St Anne's on the evening of his arrival. So, we have included a 7pm Mass this coming Wednesday, as it is also the Feast of the Most Precious Blood. For the first one year after a man has been ordained to the sacred priesthood he is able to give 'first' blessings. These are special blessings that have a plenary indulgence attached to them. Of course, one must meet all the conditions required in order to receive the plenary indulgence. So, Fr Nguyen will be giving **some** blessings in the hall after the Wednesday Mass. But, no need to rush!!! He can give these blessing any day up until late May 2027. Let's make him welcome here. Introduce yourself to him casually, it will take him a long time to memorise names (I don't know half of you! - not entirely my fault also!).

I am urging everyone to get behind the fundraising raffle for the Footsteps Pilgrimage and also the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary dinner, where the raffle will be drawn. This will be our main social event of the year (along with our Christmas picnic) and will give an opportune place to meet and greet Fr Nguyen, socialise with others who you see at church but perhaps know very little of., and also to congratulate all those who received their first holy Communion earlier in the Day.

# THE FEAST OF ST. PETER AND ST. PAUL

# ALLELUIA

*Matt 16:18*

## INTROIT

*Acts 12:11, Ps 138:1-2*

Now I know for certain that the Lord has sent His angel, and rescued me from the power of Herod, and from all that the Jewish people were expecting. *Ps.* O Lord, You have probed me and You know me; You know when I sit and when I stand.

## COLLECT

O God, Who made this day holy by the martyrdom of Your Apostles Peter and Paul, grant Your Church to follow in all things the teaching of those from whom she first received the faith.

## EPISTLE

*Acts 12:1-11*

And at the same time, Herod the king stretched forth his hands, to afflict some of the church. And he killed James, the brother of John, with the sword. And seeing that it pleased the Jews, he proceeded to take up Peter also. Now it was in the days of the Azymes. And when he had apprehended him, he cast him into prison, delivering him to four files of soldiers to be kept, intending, after the pasch, to bring him forth to the people. Peter therefore was kept in prison. But prayer was made without ceasing by the church unto God for him. And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison. And behold an angel of the Lord stood by him: and a light shined in the room: and he striking Peter on the side, raised him up, saying: Arise quickly. And the chains fell off from his hands. And the angel said to him: Gird thyself, and put on thy sandals. And he did so. And he said to him: Cast thy garment about thee, and follow me. And going out, he followed him, and he knew not that it was true which was done by the angel: but thought he saw a vision. And passing through the first and the second ward, they came to the iron gate that leadeth to the city, which of itself opened to them. And going out, they passed on through one street: and immediately the angel departed from him.

And Peter coming to himself, said: Now I know in very deed, that the Lord hath sent his angel, and hath delivered me out of the hand of Herod, and from all the expectation of the people of the Jews.

And I say to thee: That thou art Peter; and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give to thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven. 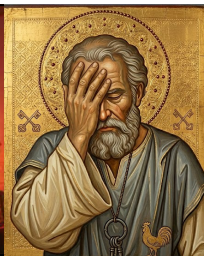
