Pax Christi,

Rejoice, as we are coming closer to the Nativity of our Divine Saviour. Planning is underway to have Christmas liturgies as widely available as possible given the current government overreach. Also, with St Paul's College chapel still unavailable to us, we will have to be innovative and flexible. The immediate plan is to have the midnight Mass outside. This will (of course) depend on the weather, which we will not know until a few days prior, so the actual place of the Mass will be decided in the few days before Christmas. If the weather looks favourable, we will hire a large tent which will be open on three sides and erect it on the large grass area on the corner of Flanshaw and Cole Pl. An altar will be erected on the grass (depending on wind direction) and the tent will be candlelit. This way as many people as possible will be able to assist, and the atmosphere of having a candlelit Mass for midnight Mass is quite exciting.

Due to the increasing encroachment of the government into our privacy, I am hearing of several parents considering removing their children from schools so as to keep autonomy over their loved ones. If anyone is in this situation, and would like to speak to like minded Catholics about options for schooling in 2022, please speak to Fr Sumich and if there are a sufficient number, then we will organise a meeting of those interested and see what can be done by way of collaboration.

We still have 2022 liturgical calendars for sale if you want, but they are going fast.

Also, it is "that" time of year again when the Epiphany House blessing sign-up sheets will be in the chapel foyer. The dates for the blessings are Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> January - Friday 14<sup>th</sup> January (inclusive), and as in past years the blessings are strictly done during that Octave of Epiphany. If you will be away during these dates, we will furnish you with the prayers to be said, chalk for writing on the doors and the Epiphany holy water. As always, these blessing are reserved for those who attend Latin Masses at our chapels and NOT family of our parishioners. Oh, and of course, the very important rule still holds ; "Don't feed the priest!"

### INTROIT

*Philippians 4. 4-6, Psalm 84:2*

Rejoice in the Lord always: again I say, rejoice. Let your modesty be known to all men: for the Lord is nigh. Be nothing solicitous: but in every thing by prayer let your petitions be made known to God. *Ps.* Lord, Thou hast blessed Thy land: Thou hast turned away the captivity of Jacob. *V.* Glory be to the Father.

### COLLECT

Incline Thine ear to our prayers we beseech Thee, O Lord; and enlighten the darkness of our minds by the grace of Thy visitation: Who livest.

And they asked him: What then? Art thou Elias? And he said: I am not. Art thou the Prophet? And he answered: No. They said therefore unto him: Who art thou, that we may give an answer to them that sent us? What sayest thou of thyself? He said: I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the Prophet Isaias. And they that were sent were of the Pharisees. And they asked him, and said to him: Why then dost thou baptise; if thou be not Christ, nor Elias, nor the Prophet? John answered them, saying: I baptise with water: but there hath stood one in the midst of you, whom you know not. The

same is He that shall come after me, who is preferred before me: the latchet of whose shoe I am not worthy to loose. These things were done in Bethania, beyond the Jordan, where John was baptising.

## THE "TRAFFIC LIGHT" ARRANGEMENTS

St Anne's Chapel will not be using the "Vaccine Pass". Therefore, there will be no "Vaccinated only" Mass in the Latin Mass Chaplaincy. If you would like to attend such a Mass, please contact your local diocesan parish for information.

To satisfy the Ministry of Health guidelines during alert level "Red"

- St Anne's Chapel will be open to the public, but all visitors **MUST** make sure they sign in or record their visit using the QR code. This must be done on every visit. If you are writing your details, you must use the paper slips and box provided.

- Mt St. Mary's Chapel will be open for perpetual adoration from 12pm on Friday the 3rd December.

- All visitors **MUST** make use of the hand sanitising materials provided.

- All visitors **MUST** have a mask.

- The maximum capacity inside St Anne's Chapel and Mt St Mary's Chapel is 25 people following the social distancing rules.

- During Mass, the elderly will have priority to be inside the chapel. If you are asked to leave the chapel (by one of the ushers) to make space for people who are more in need, please follow the instructions. Hopefully, charity will prevail.

- If you are attending by standing outside the chapel during Mass, please keep social distance rules.

- Confession will follow the normal daily pre-covid schedule and communion will be given DURING Mass.

- If you are near the chapel and also watching the livestream during Mass, please use headphones. The livestream has a 1 minute delay and it is distracting for people around you.

- Please follow the instructions from the ushers in the high-viz vests at all times.

- If you are feeling sick or showing ANY signs of illness, stay at home and/or get a test.

As we preparing for Christmas both spiritually and logistically, please keep in mind that Fr Sumich can get busy with pastoral work and preparation for the liturgy.
