Pax Christi,

Greetings once again in our (fun) lockdown. Obviously we don't know the future, we don't know when all this will end (if ever). What we do know is that we will (one day) pass from this life and be judged on our choices. In the meantime, we must work out our salvation in fear and trembling. Also in the meantime we must be ready for hardships in this "vale of tears". I think it is a matter of 'when,' not 'if' regarding vaccine passports for our everyday lives. Just a cursory glance overseas shows that there is a framing of a narrative that if one is not vaccinated they are an 'enemy' of the people, they are to blame for the ills of the world. As the Book of Wisdom says, "there is nothing new under the sun" so we should be ready for a great polemic against those who have chosen not to receive this vaccine. How far could such draconian measures go? That is hard to say, definitely travel restrictions, loss of jobs, removal from schools, public places such as stadiums, bars, restaurants, gyms etc. Perhaps even supermarkets!

So, if you find yourself facing such hardships, what can you do? Prayer is the first answer in all human difficulties. Fast as if you truly want to show God you are serious about living your life as He did. If Christ were among us and these days came around, would He merely give up snacks for the day, or would He TRULY fast? There is no time like the present to offer up something to our Master, who said, "If you will be My follower, deny yourself, pick up your cross and follow Me."
