Pax Christi,

We are now at the end of the liturgical year, ready to walk into (liturgically) the New Year. We have our Advent wreath competition underway, some of you have indicated that you are attempting the St Martin's Lent by fasting 40 days for Advent and also, the Rorate Mass is coming around soon. The numbers of confessions have been great to see, and now that gatherings can take place (with restrictions) outdoors, many have decided to assist at Sunday Mass at St Anne's, albeit from outside the chapel. God bless you and your faith.

However, the elephant in the room is the impending traffic-light system and its implementation in the beginning of December. Just so we all understand. If a church is using vaccine passport checks, 50 people can attend under RED, unlimited numbers are allowed to attend under ORANGE and GREEN. If a church is NOT using vaccine passport checks, (i.e. anyone at all can attend) then 10 can attend under RED, 50 can attend under ORANGE, and 100 can attend under GREEN. The Diocesan plan with was sent out to all parishes a couple of days ago and asks priests to take into consideration all Catholics. The Bishops are asking (neighbouring) parishes to work together to provide people with all options at as many times as possible. I have made the decision to have all my Masses available for all people. Therefore I will not be making vaccine passport checks at any of my Masses. To this end, as we are expecting Auckland to begin under the Red light, which means that only 10 people can be in the church for religious services, I invite the elderly to be seated in the chapel and all others will have to assist by being outside the chapel (as we are currently doing). The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at Mt St Mary's once the traffic light system begins. When we move to Orange, I will continue to use St Anne's for all Masses including Sundays and only under Green will I consider moving the Sunday Mass to St Paul's. The school are enquiring if we can use the chapel if not using the vaccine passport checks. The priests of the Auckland deaneries will meet this coming week and there should be a list of parishes providing Masses for vaccinated-only forthcoming.

GOSPEL

Matthew 13. 31-35

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: When you shall see the abomination of desolation, which was spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place; (he that readeth, let him understand;) then they that are in Judea, let them flee to the mountains; and he that is on the housetop, let him not come down to take anything out of his house; and he that is in the field, let him not go back to take his coat. And woe to them that are with child, and that give suck, in those days. But pray that your flight be not in the winter, or

on the sabbath: for there shall be then great tribulation, such as hath not been found from the beginning of the world until now neither shall be: and unless those days had been shortened, no flesh should be saved; but for the sake of the elect, those days shall be shortened. Then if any man shall say to you: Lo, here is Christ, or there; do not believe him; for there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders, insomuch as to deceive (if possible) even the elect. Behold I have told it to you beforehand: if therefore they shall say to you: Behold He is in the desert, go ye not out; behold He is in the closets, believe it not. For as lightning cometh out of the east, and appeareth even into the west, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. Wheresoever the body shall be, there shall the eagles also be gathered together. And immediately after the tribulation of those days, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of heaven shall be moved; and then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven, and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn; and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with much power and majesty; and He shall send His angels with a trumpet and a great voice, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest parts of the heavens to the utmost bounds of them. And from the fig tree learn a parable: when the branch thereof is now tender, and the leaves come forth, you know that summer is nigh. So you also, when you shall see all these things, know ye that it is nigh even at the doors. Amen I say to you that this generation shall not pass till all these things be done. Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My words shall not pass away.
