Pax Christi,

Happy New (liturgical) Year, may it bring us joy and blessings from our Lord, whose birth we are now anticipating. Once again, I think it necessary to repeat what I have said over the last few weeks. As we enter the unknown zone of life under vaccine mandate laws, it is imperative that whatever your situation is, you place as your highest priority, being in the state of grace and remaining so. Nothing else will matter at the end of time. Remembering, that to be in that state, you must have no unconfessed mortal sin on your soul, and to remain in that state, you much live in charity. Take all that will come across your path in the coming weeks as being permitted by God, for your sanctification.

Let us concentrate in the season of preparation on our own spiritual welfare, using the opportunity given to us by our mother the Church, to practice the curbing and eradication of our vices. Advent is a time of fasting and penance which, if used properly can bring down blessings upon ourselves and those for whom we pray. Make use therefore, of this time by choosing an adequate fast. Choose a form of penance suited to your spiritual needs and capabilities, ask your confessor for permission, and God, for the grace to persevere. Heaven is a reward and cannot be gained by social media scrolling or internet browsing. To advance in holiness one MUST conquer themselves, this is done by denying ourselves of all that is superfluous, trite, time-wasting and worldly. The reason growth in the spiritual life is referred to as 'spiritual warfare' is not just because one must do battle with the demons, but because one must do battle with one's own fallen human nature. Doing 'violence' to oneself is not cutting one's own flesh with a knife, rather it is doing violence to own's own weak. fallen nature, one's weak will, and denying one's self the easy way. Choose instead the narrow path, choose the rocky road, choose the unpopular prayer time instead of the respect of the world. In short, choose the model of Christ, our perfect example. Let us walk honestly, as in the day: not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and impurities, not in contention and

envy: but put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ.
