Pax Christi,

Happy Feast day of Christ the King wherever you may be. This is a great day in the Church and our only regret ought to be that we are unable to celebrate by means of a Solemn Mass and procession. Let us praise and honour Christ, our King throughout this day and in our lives, living for Him as His most loyal subjects, following His example, laws and love. At the end of today's Mass, I will be reciting the Act of Consecration of the Human Race to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. I invite all of you to join in this prayer during the Mass (it is on this bulletin), but if you are unable to do so at the Mass, then please do so at some time during the day.

I was once discussing liturgical things with a Bishop and he suggested that the two calendars for the Traditional Latin Mass and the New Mass needed to be made into one. He used as an example the Feast of Christ the King, and asked why it was in October and not at the end of the liturgical year in late November (as it is in the *Novus Ordo*). In reply, I drew his attention to the encyclical *Quas Primas* of Pope Pius XI who instituted this Feast. The Holy Father had this to say, "*The last Sunday of October seemed the most convenient of all for this purpose, because it is at the end of the liturgical year, and thus the feast of the Kingship of Christ sets the crowning glory upon the mysteries of the life of Christ already commemorated during the year, and, before celebrating the triumph of all the Saints, we proclaim and extol the glory of him who triumphs in all the Saints and in all the Elect.*" Although the end of November is properly the end of the liturgical year, the Holy Father is placing the Feast immediately before the triumph of all the Saints. He is of course referring to all the souls who are members of the Church Triumphant in heaven - whether they are canonised or not, AND all the souls of the elect who are going to be in heaven, but are currently expiating for their sins in purgatory, thus, the Church Suffering.

We need to understand how this works. Christ said to Pilate, "*My Kingdom is not of this world*" which clearly refers to the world of sin. He is the King of all that souls who He has won by His victory. All souls (even those before His time) who are among the elect, have Jesus as their King. All the Souls in heaven and in purgatory hail His reign, they bow down in supplication, love, awe & gratitude to the all conquering Monarch. This they do constantly, seeing as they are no longer constrained by the weakness of their earthly bodies, they now understand the fullness of His Kingship. For now His spiritual Kingship reigns in their hearts. As for us in the Church Militant, we must fight for His rights among men, especially as societies reject Him. Due to the hypostatic union of His two natures (being God and man), He has dominion of all creatures, a dominion that can never be seized or usurped, quite simply He rules by right of His essence and nature. He can be rejected by man (due to free-will) but that does not (and cannot) erase His absolute rule. He is bound to be adored by angels and men. So, today's Feast is the humble effort of the Church Militant to worship our King, because we will then be followed by all the Saints, who praise the King forever.

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## THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

## GOSPEL

*John 18. 33-37*

**INTROIT** *Apocalypse 5. 12, 1-6, Ps. 71: 1*

The Lamb that was slain is worthy to receive the power and divinity and wisdom and strength and honour: to Him be glory and empire for ever and ever. *Ps.* Give to the King, O God, Thy judgment, and to the King's Son Thy justice. *V.* Glory be to the Father.

**COLLECT**

Almighty everlasting God, Who in Thy beloved Son, King of the whole world, hast willed to restore all things anew; grant in Thy mercy that all the families of nations, rent asunder by the wound of sin, may be subjected to His most gentle rule. Who with Thee liveth and reigneth.

**EPISTLE** *Col. 1.12-20*

Brethren: We give thanks to God, the Father, Who hath made us worthy to be partakers of the lot of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of the Son of His love. In Whom we have redemption through His blood, the remission of sins; Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature for in Him were all things created in Heaven and on earth visible and invisible, whether thrones, or dominations, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him and in Him. And He is before all, and by Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body of the Church, Who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things He may hold the primacy: because in Him hath well pleased the Father that all fullness should dwell; and through Him to reconcile all things unto Himself, making peace through the Blood of His Cross, both as to the things that are on earth, and the things that are in Heaven, in Christ Jesus Our Lord.

**GRADUAL** *Psalms 71. 8-11*

He shall rule from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth. *V.* And all kings of the earth shall adore Him: all nations shall serve Him.

**ALLELUIA** *Daniel 7. 14*

Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* His power is an everlasting power that shall not be taken away: and His kingdom that shall not be destroyed. Alleluia.

**A**t that time: Pilate said to Jesus: Art thou the King of the Jews? Jesus answered: Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or have others told it thee of Me? Pilate answered: Am I a Jew? Thy own nation, and the chief priests, have delivered thee up to me: what hast thou done? Jesus answered: My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would certainly strive that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now My kingdom is not from hence. Pilate therefore said to him: Art thou a king then? Jesus answered: Thou sayest that I am a King. For this was I born, and for I this came I into the world; that I should give testimony to the truth, Everyone that is of the truth, heareth My voice.

**OFFERTORY** *Psalms 2. 8*

Ask of Me and I will give Thee the nations for Thine inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Thy possession.

**SECRET**

We offer Thee, O Lord, the victim of man's reconciliation: grant, we beseech Thee, that Jesus Christ, Thy Son, our Lord, Whom we immolate in our present sacrifices, may Himself bestow on all nations the gifts of unity and peace: Who with Thee liveth and reigneth.

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times and in all places, give thanks unto Thee, O holy Lord, Father almighty, eternal God Who didst anoint with the oil of gladness Thine only-begotten Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, eternal Priest and King of the universe: that, offering Himself as a stainless peace-offering on the altar of the cross, He might fulfil the pledges of man's redemption; and, having all creatures subject to His power, might deliver to Thy sublime majesty an eternal and universal kingdom, a kingdom of truth and life; a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace. And therefore with the Angels and Archangels, with the Thrones and Dominations, and with all the array of the Heavenly host, we sing a hymn to Thy glory and unceasingly repeat:

## Act of Consecration of the Human Race to the Sacred Heart of Jesus
